

DECCA DISCOGRAPHY

>>I ITALY & Monte Carlo

Until the mid-1960s it was taken for granted that the place to record Italian opera was Italy. After a few sessions in Milan (lost to EMI in 1954) and a recording with the Turin Symphony Orchestra during a visit to London in 1947 (AR11722-47), Decca settled on Rome from 1950-70, plus Florence from 1955-63, with an excursion to Naples in 1964. Monte Carlo followed from 1967-69 and Bologna from 1973-77, but by then London had become the world's capital for recording operas, whether Italian, French, German or English. Del Monaco was the reigning tenor from 1952-69 and Tebaldi the reigning soprano from 1951-73. Their successors Pavarotti (1964-99) and Sutherland (1959-87) recorded mainly in London and regular sessions in Italy only resumed with Chailly, in Bologna from 1986-93 and Milan since 1995. In the twenty-first century opera recording in Italy has regained something of the status it enjoyed fifty years earlier, though both Bartoli (from 1988) and Flórez (from 1998) have also recorded extensively elsewhere.

VENUES

Thirty-eight different venues were used, but only four (those in **bold**) hosted ten or more entries, whilst twenty-one were only visited once. Evidently finding satisfactory locations in Bologna and Milan proved difficult.

AULA ABSIDALE DI SANTA LUCIA, BOLOGNA, Emilia Romagna (1988), a 300 seat hall set in the apse of a church (1659), was visited twice in 1991-92 to record the local chamber orchestra.

Chiesa di SAN GIORGIO POGGIALE, BOLOGNA, Emilia Romagna (1633) was preferred to the opera house for four recordings from 1985-87.

TEATRO COMMUNALE, BOLOGNA, Emilia Romagna (1757), a 1000 seat opera house rebuilt in 1935, was used on at least ten occasions, in 1973 and from 1987-97. Three recordings from 1974-77 may also have been made there.

TEATRO MANZONI, BOLOGNA, Emilia Romagna (1933), originally a 3000 seat cinema, was the venue for opera sessions in 2004.

VILLA ALDROVANDI-MAZZACORATI, BOLOGNA, Emilia Romagna (1763) houses a tiny private theatre that was the original choice for recording the Filarmonici in 1990.

TEATRO MASSIMO BELLINI, CATANIA, Sicilia (1890), a 1200 seat opera house, was visited in 2001-2 to record two productions.

CASA ROMEI, FERRARA, Emilia Romagna (1442), a renaissance palace, was selected in 2002 for a single recording of Accademia Bizantina.

TEATRO COMMUNALE, FLORENCE, Toscana (1862), a 2000 seat house rebuilt in 1961, was favoured for two Maggio Musicale Fiorentino operas, in 1990 and 2001.

TEATRO PERGOLA, FLORENCE, Toscana (1656), a 1500 seat opera house, was used regularly from 1955-63 for fifteen MMF operatic recordings.

TEATRO VERDI, FLORENCE, Toscana (1854), a 1500 seat house, hosted just one MMF opera in 1991.

TEATRO CARLO FELICE, GENOA, Liguria (1828), a 2000 seat opera house rebuilt in 1991, staged a televised production in 2005.

Chiesa Parrocchia di SAN MARTINO, LUVIGLIANO, Torreglia, near Padua, Veneto (c1474) was chosen in 1990 for Argo choral sessions.

TEATRO DEL BIBBIENA, MANTUA, Lombardia (1770) was Sviatoslav Richter's venue for three recordings in 1986-87.

AUDITORIUM DI MILANO, MILAN, Lombardia (1999), a 1250 seat concert hall rebuilt from the Cinema Massimo (1939), was used thirteen times from 2000-8, mainly for the resident Giuseppe Verdi Symphony Orchestra.

CHIESA DELLA PACE, MILAN, Lombardia (1497) was visited in 1995 to record overtures with the La Scala orchestra.

CTC [Centro Telecinematografico Culturale] STUDIOS, MILAN, Lombardia (c1970), evidently an Italian counterpart to CTS Studios, Wembley, hosted a single album of arias in 1998.

TEATRO STUDIO, Piccolo Teatro, MILAN, Lombardia (1987), a 400 seat auditorium, was used in 1998 for two La Scala recordings.

SALA ABANELLA, MILAN, Lombardia (1985), a former cinema adapted as a rehearsal hall for La Scala, saw sessions for two operas from 1985-88.

SALA VERDI, Conservatorio, MILAN, Lombardia (1958), a 1500 seat concert hall, was chosen for five vocal and operatic recordings from 1997-99.

Chiesa di SANTA MARIA DELLE GRAZIE, MILAN, Lombardia (c1490) was favoured for a 1996 recording using La Scala's orchestra.

TEATRO ALLA SCALA, MILAN, Lombardia (1778), a 2800 seat opera house, staged a televised production in 2006. It may also have been the venue for five 1947 recordings of the company's orchestra and a 1954 opera recording.

PIAZZA GRANDE, MODENA, Emilia Romagna was the scene of an open air Pavarotti concert in 1993.

SALLE ALCAZAR, MONTE CARLO, Monaco was used from 1967-69 for seven recordings with the local opera orchestra, as the tiny 500 seat opera house (1879) was presumably unsuitable.

CONSERVATORIO di Musica San Pietro a Maiella, NAPLES, Campania (1826), based in a former convent, was visited for three recordings with the local orchestra in 1964.

AUDITORIUM NICCOLÒ PAGANINI, PARMA, Emilia Romagna (2001), an 800 seat hall constructed within the shell of a former sugar factory (1899), was chosen for an album of arias in 2008.

TEATRO ROSSINI, PESARO, Marche (1818), a 900 seat opera house and home to the Rossini Opera Festival since 1980, saw a 2004 production recorded.

MUSEO NAZIONALE, RAVENNA, Emilia Romagna (1804), housed in a former monastery, was used just once in 2007 to record Accademia Bizantina.

TEATRO VALLI, REGGIO EMILIA, Emilia Romagna (1857), an 1100 seat opera house, was treated to a televised Pavarotti gala concert in 1991.

AUDITORIUM PARCO DELLA MUSICA, ROME, Lazio (2002), a 2750 seat concert hall built as a new home for the Santa Cecilia Academy Orchestra, was the venue for a 2006 album of arias.

RCA ITALIANA STUDIOS, Via Tiburtina, near ROME, Lazio (1961) hosted four recordings using Rome Opera forces from 1963-66.

Sala Accademica, **SANTA CECILIA, ROME**, Lazio (1895) was used frequently from 1951-70, and once more in 1998, for operas, recitals and occasional orchestral, chamber and piano sessions. [64 entries]

TEATRO DELL'OPERA, ROME, Lazio (1880), a 1600 seat house, was visited only once for a production recorded by RCA in 1961.

TERME DI CARACALLA, ROME, Lazio (217), an ancient Roman baths and leisure complex, saw the original 1990 "Three Tenors" open air concert.

CONSERVATORIO, TURIN, Piemonte (1936) includes a 700 seat concert hall that was used in 1995 to record arias with the Torino Teatro Regio Orchestra.

TEATRO LA FENICE, VENICE, Veneto (1792), a 1000 seat opera house rebuilt in 1837, was visited three times in 1961, 1990 and 1991. It lived up to its name by being burnt out yet again in 1996 and restored in 2004.

ARENA DI VERONA, Veneto (30), a 22000 seat Roman arena that has staged operas since 1913, was the venue for a 2007 video recording.

SALA MAFFEIANA, VERONA, Veneto (1754), a hall where Mozart played in 1770, hosted a single piano recording in 2004.

TEATRO OLIMPICO, VICENZA, Veneto (1585), a 1000 seat house, was the setting for a 1998 recital by Cecilia Bartoli.

Venues have not been identified or verified for a few recordings from 1947-65.
